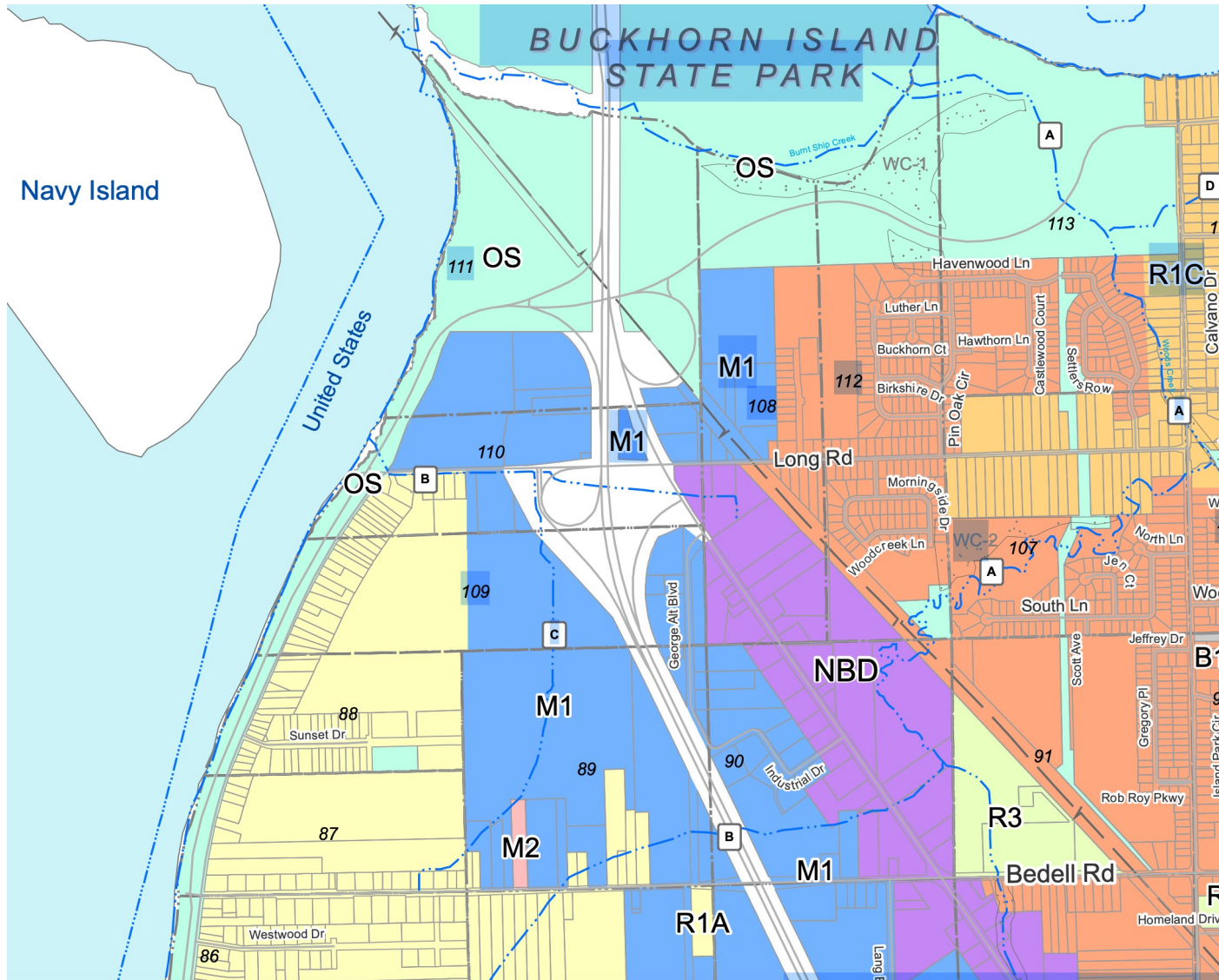

Lisa Bukachevsky in Edison, NJ who lives near a 900,000 sq. foot Amazon Fulfillment center on Rt.27 stated, “the wall erected to reduce noise does not work.” Additionally, she was told that there would not be an increase in noise due to holidays, but she stated, “that’s not true, it’s pretty bad.” Another resident of Edison stated the facility and the truck traffic has a greater impact at night, stating they could not even sleep because the noise level was so excessive.
